I have experience in revision knee surgery for infection and loosening using one or two stage techniques and mainly using TC3, modular and hinged implants.

Working for Mr Bollen and Radcliff has given me an opportunity to undergo training in arthroscopic soft tissue knee surgery. I am now in a position to carry out a wide range of arthroscopic knee surgery including (meniscal Surgery, lateral patellar release, patellar tendon decompression, micro fracture technique for localised chondral lesion and chondroplasty) , ACL , PCL, PLC Reconstruction, and repair of combined ligaments of Acutely injured knee.

### **Hip Arthroplasty Surgery**

During my Hip fellowship appointment with Mr Jain, I have exposed to wide range of hip disorders and pathology including degenerative hip disease in young people and their Surgical management including Hip resurfacing and Articular Surface replacement, metal on metal bearing, uncemented Hip replacement and Revision Hip Surgery.
